Description: Country music trio Gloriana will release their much anticipated second studio album A Thousand Miles Left Behind on Emblem Music Group/Warner Bros. Records July 31st. The band had a hand in writing all 11 tracks on the album and worked with GRAMMY Award winning producer and Emblem Music Group label owner Matt Serletic (Willie Nelson, Matchbox 20, and Aerosmith). Their single "(Kissed You) Good Night" is currently #15 on the Billboard Country Singles chart and has become the fastest rising single of the trio's career.

"We've grown up a lot as a band and have really honed in on our skills and found our sound," Mike says. "On this record, we wanted to tell stories and I think people will be able to relate to a lot of these songs because they're honest and come from a place that's real," added Rachel. "Like any new act, we were finding ourselves on the first record — in the recording process and as musicians," Tom says. "The new album really just feels like us, who and where we are now, to the point where we know exactly what we want to do and how to get there.'

Tom, Mike, and Rachel have funneled everything they've learned into their second album, A Thousand Miles Left Behind, intent on revealing more of themselves as artists. The result is an alluring mix of up-tempo songs, "Wanna Take You Home," "Sunset Lovin," "Go On...Miss Me," "Doin' It Our Way," and graceful, heartfelt tunes: current single "(Kissed You) Good Night," "Can't Shake You," "Turn My World Around," "Carolina Rose," and "Soldier Song". **Gloriana** worked with some of Nashville's finest songwriters for the album including Josh Kear (Carrie Underwood and Lady Antebellum), Hillary Lindsey (Carrie Underwood and Taylor Swift), James Slater (Martina McBride and Tim McGraw), Danny Myrick (Jason Aldean and Big & Rich), Stephanie Bentley (Martina McBride and Faith Hill), among others.

Description: Several months after releasing their first album, **The Smiths** issued this collection of singles and rarities, several of which are BBC versions of songs from their debut. **The Smiths** treated singles as individual entities, not just ways to promote an album, and therefore many of there finest songs were never issued on their studio albums. As if this wasn't enough, this compilation contains the first appearance of what may be the band's finest moment. "How Soon Is Now" encapsulates everything good about **The Smiths**; Morrissey's mocking lyrics, Marr's stunning vibrato guitar and a rhythm section you could set your watch to.

Contrived by Johnny Marr, **The Smiths** evolved when Marr unearthed Morrissey and insisted upon a collaboration. The idea was to produce songs which were always instantaneous and listenable whilst also provoking deep thought; emeshing Morrissey's words with Marr's music in a sound which, above all, would stand apart without being inaccessible or esoteric. The guitar-based songs would blend melody without havoc, as the words - born out of absolute physical necessity - would tug at the straps of cultural straightjackets.

Christened as an antidote to a prevalent idea that modern groups would near a far-reaching, multi-syllabic name to authorise their artistry, **The Smiths** were completed with Andy Rourke (the bass guitar) and Mike Joyce (the drums). Joyce had served time with a clump of healthily depraved groups, whilst the other three members were without any serious musical involvement. **The Smiths** first surfaced in September '82, and the group determined that all their moves be surefooted and worthwhile. As a live group, **The Smiths** believed that it was possible to replenish appetites of both the soul and the pelvis simultaneously. They were urban, but never bleak; there was a humour in tragedy, solace in unity. The voice was the collective rage of all suppressed hysterics: Morrissey popularised the creased brow.

Always Manchester-based, The Smiths contended that "one has to live somewhere..." and soon rewrote the history of

their city. Following misdirected collisions with major record companies, the group were adopted by Rough Trade, and the first result was the single "Hand in Glove / Handsome Devil." The sound attacked the depersonalised sterility of their contemporaries whose clinical synthesized rhythms, **The Smiths** believed, left audiences feeling non-human and petrified of emotion. Lyrically, the fundamental idea was to use phraseology which had simply never been used before.

The Smiths took firm control of any promotional images which bore their name, and naturally their artwork would always counteract accepted ingredients of popular music, without being hostile. The Smiths maintained the integrity and ethos of their manifesto across four studio albums and a live album that was issued after their split. Their legacy matches their original ambition - to produce songs which were always instantaneous and listenable whilst also provoking deep thought. And there you are.

Description: What We Saw From The Cheap Seats reunites Spektor with production partner Mike Elizondo (Eminem, Fiona Apple, Dr. Dre) and is her first album of new material since 2009's far. The album is set to launch May 29, 2012.

What We Saw From The Cheap Seats was recorded over an eight week period this past summer in Los Angeles. Spektor wrote each of the 11 tracks on the album. She arrived at the session with a collection of new compositions, but others were pulled from earlier periods. She and Elizondo fleshed out instrumentation and sought to make each of the songs stand alone sonically. Most of the songs were recorded live with Spektor on piano and vocals, while additional instrumentation was added to these original takes. Of working with Spektor, Elizondo says "Regina Spektor is that rare artist that continues to surprise. Just when you think you have her figured out, she knocks you out with something completely different. It's that spirit that drives this record. Each song takes you on a journey that only Regina is capable of providing. She has truly outdone herself."

Since emerging on the NYC café circuit in 2001, this Russian-born, Bronx-bred artist has been hailed as a truly special talent. With an uninhibited imagination and acute sense of detail both in music and words, **Regina Spektor** has gone from practicing on an out of tune piano in the basement of her local synagogue to hypnotizing small crowds in NYC's lower East Side to selling out venues like New York's Radio City Music Hall worldwide.

Spektor released her last studio album <u>Far</u>, to an overwhelming response from both fans and critics and it debuted at #3 on the Billboard Top 200. Since her appearance on the BBC's *Later ... with Jools Holland* in the fall of 2011, the excitement around Lianne has quickly spread across the UK, Europe and the US. Appearing on that same episode of *Later ...* was **Bon Iver**, which quickly led to an offer for Lianne to open their December North American tour. "As soon as we saw her play it was so refreshing; somebody who could play their instrument, somebody who could use their voice, but in their own way. She is just fantastic," Bon Iver's Justin Vernon told *Esquire* (UK).

La Havas says that *Is Your Love Big Enough?* "acts almost like a map of the route I have taken through life, through love, in the past three years. The title is a question that mixes challenge, defiance, impatience, determination, pride, and, above all. passion. It demands an answer."

La Havas was nominated for the **BBC's Sound of 2012** honor and was chosen as one of **MTV's Hot Tips for 2012**. A native of South London, with Greek and Jamaican parents, La Havas began teaching herself to play piano, write songs, and sing at the age of seven. Her family's diverse taste was very influential, as she told *Time Out London*, when she was a child, her grandparents babysat her often: "They're from Jamaica, so when I was growing up I listened to a lot of religious reggae-almost hymns, but in a reggae style-on cassettes. But at the same time my mother was listening to a lot of '80s and '90s Michael Jackson, and Mary J Blige, who I loved from a very early age. Plus India.Arie, Jill Scott, and The Fugees. I saw my father often, and he played the accordion, piano, and guitar." La Havas began singing backup for other musicians while attending art college for a year before deciding to focus on her own career as a solo artist and songwriter.

One night last October, **Lianne La Havas'** life changed on a dime. The 22-year-old London-born singer, songwriter, and guitarist had been asked to appear on the influential British music show **Later... with Jools Holland** (a rare invitation for an unknown artist), and she made sure to take advantage of her moment. Cutting a striking figure in a white pleated skirt and side-swept poof of hair, with a radiant smile spread across her face, La Havas performed "Age"-a playful tune about a dalliance with an older man-with effortless grace and charm. When the show aired, the reaction was instantaneous and unanimous: Lianne La Havas was on her way to becoming a star. "With her electric guitar strung high, and her beautiful, smoky, vibrato-rich croon of a voice enunciating every word, she seems to be confiding in you directly, with no filter in between-a strange (and rare) mix of fragility ... and impregnable, ensnaring confidence," raved the UK's Sunday *Times* about the performance.

"I just hoped to play well and not make any mistakes," La Havas says with characteristic modesty. "It actually felt like the first time I ever sang in front of an audience at school. I was terrified!" Her undetectable stage fright notwithstanding, the captivating performance spoke volumes about this young newcomer, who, at that point, had been signed to Warner Bros. Records and subsequently released two EP's in the U.K. (*Lost & Found* and *Forget*). She was also busy writing and recording songs for her full-length debut album, *Is Your Love Big Enough?*

Following La Havas' performance on *Later...*, her London club residency sold out in a few hours and she was tapped by **Bon Iver's Justin Vernon**, who had also appeared on the program that night, to open his band's North American tour in December 2011. She was nominated for the BBC's Sound of 2012-an annual poll of music critics and industry figures to find the most promising new musical talent (past winners include Adele and Jessie J).

Then **Prince** called and invited La Havas to visit him at his Paisley Park studio in Minneapolis, where the two spoke about music for hours and played guitar together. ("We were kind of jamming, and he fed me a line on the bass while he got on the drums," she recalls. "We were just having a fun evening.") **Stevie Wonder** turned up at her sold-out show at L.A.'s intimate Bootleg Theater (capacity: 450) and chatted with her for an hour afterward. "He was very complimentary about my songs and said it was like listening to India.Arie for the first time," she says.)

La Havas was recently hand-selected by the legendary Robert Plant to open for him and she is also set to open for her

longtime hero **Erykah Badu** in London-a bill that she has described as a "dream show" for her, recently telling *NYLON* Magazine, "I'd love to support Erykah Badu, just so I could meet her."

What those musical legends have undoubtedly responded to is not only La Havas' obvious talent as a vocalist and songwriter, but also her warmth and ability to connect as a performer-qualities that extend to *Is Your Love Big Enough?*. Recorded in Brooklyn and Los Angeles, the album was produced by fellow Brit Matt Hales (Aqualung), who also co-wrote several of the songs. "The first time I saw Matt, I felt like I knew him already," La Havas says. "He really helped nurture my strengths; I just trust him." She formed a songwriting partnership with Hales and followed him to Los Angeles, where, in 2010, she was offered a development deal with Warner Bros. Records, giving her the luxury of time to develop her lean, nimble approach to blending soul, jazz, and folk. Together La Havas and Hales conjured up the songs on *Is Your Love Big Enough?* — a stylistically diverse c
